*A group of friends and family gathered to grieve with a couple at our church for the loss of their baby at 25 weeks. We prayed, we sang, we grieved with them. But it is still true that a day will come when we will "weep no more."

*Our worker in Spain collapsed in a pharmacy and his heart stopped beating for 20 minutes. The doctors thought he was dead but he was resuscitated and taken to a local hospital. A few days later he was smiling at his wife. He is still confused. This is God's miracle, but please pray for complete healing.

*The Asha shop that was burned last September is now getting ready to reopen. It has been a long time of negotiations with the landlord, but now with God's blessing it is being redone and will open soon. Pray it will be a blessing to the Kenton area.

*I often use mini cabs to travel. God gives really good conversations with Muslim, Sikh and Hindu drivers. Pray that the Spirit will open their hearts to hear the good news.

*Prague: an invitation for Keren and me to spend time with the church and fellow workers there: hopefully early March.

*Healing. Last Sunday the elders at New Life Masih Gahr prayed that God would heal my persistent back pain. They prayed, God took away the pain.

*Bob in India, meeting many old friends and connecting with new ones. It has been a long trip and still not over. Please pray for God's anointing.

It is still true there will come a time when "We will sing with our hearts restored." So we say, "Come Lord Jesus come."

Thank you for all who respond to these updates. Heaven hears, and answers.
