*What should the exterior of New Life look like?

The aspect of the preliminary building renovations that garnered the most comments after our Vision Night meeting was the exterior facade. Comments ranged from "It's awful" to "This is great," and from "It doesn't reflect us" to "It doesn't reflect Glenside" to "I can see myself here." In order to ask the architect for a new design, we need to provide some direction. Here's the plan. Go take a picture or find a drawing that reflects what you think the architect should incorporate in the design and then email it to Greg Raysor at graysor@newlifeglenside.com or drop it off at the church office. Greg will collect them and put them on display for more input from the congregation. This will not take us to "the design," but it will give input to finishes and styles that together we prefer. The front of the Weldon Hotel portion of the building will not change.
