Giving Suggestions

1. Online Giving can be accomplished by using your bank's "Online Bill Pay" system. Most banks have a website where you can create reoccurring payments. Using your bank's online system to give your offering saves New Life Church the cost of a third party online giving company and can be easier for you to manage.

The church will be charged additional fees when credit cards or debit cards are used.
