## Pray for the Harvest

Hello from Puerto Rico! The semester just ended for most students and teachers. However, the University of Puerto Rico students just finished a 2-month strike and are heading back to school. UPR is the main public university and it serves about 58,000 students island-wide with diverse programs.

The issues are complex, but the students were protesting the large cuts in funding that were mandated by the government and the Fiscal Control Board, which was set up by the U.S. to monitor and give oversight to the struggling economic situation here. There are strong opinions on every side, but we do feel the pain of our student and teacher friends from church who are attempting to finish their semesters and research over the summer.

Joe is encouraged by his theology classes at Torre Fuerte church. The students who just completed their 18 months of study with various teachers and classes and asking for more! Forty new students are signed up to start with Joe in August. (An energetic group from the church helped us move from our apartment, which sold in March, to a townhouse nearby. We—and our backs—needed them!) Joe will also teach a modular course at a seminary here the week of August 7th.

Summer holds some travel plans for us. Anna and Justin are currently in Colombia for the first Mission to the World Latin America teen retreat. In late June, our family will come to PA/DE for Anna and Justin to join New Life's youth mission trips! We're grateful for the opportunity for them to serve with our home church. Finally, we are excited to worship with you all after a stressful few months and are so grateful for your partnership!
