Giving Suggestions

1. Online Giving can be accomplished by using your bank's "Online Bill Pay" system. Most banks have a place to make this a reoccurring payment. Using your bank's online system to give your offering saves New Life Church the cost of a third party online giving company and can be easier for you to manage.
2. You may also donate by going on to the New Life website: www.newlifewebsite.com and select the DONATE button at the top left of the home page, which takes you to a secure site where you may donate on a one time basis or on a regularly scheduled basis. A caution: The Session does not think it is good stewardship to use credit to contribute to our ministry (and keep in mind that the church will be charged hefty fees when credit cards or debit cards are used). If you set up an automatic transfer from your bank to New Life's checking account the cost to New Life is a minimal .45/transaction.

1. You are taking a step of faith – When you sign up to give online you are deciding in advance to faithfully give. God always blesses that kind of faith!
