1. Online Giving can be accomplished by using your bank's "Online Bill Pay" system. Most banks have a website where you can create reoccurring payments. This takes you to a secure site where you may donate on a one time basis or on a regularly scheduled basis using a credit card or ATM card. Caution: The Session does not think it is good stewardship to use credit to contribute to our ministry. There are nominal account and transaction fees for any deposit account. The church will be charged additional fees when credit cards or debit cards are used.
