Their sponsor license in the UK has been REINSTATED. There were 13 distinct issues raised. In three cases, there were mistakes and corrections were made. They were not major infractions; but the other issues required that the UK accept the explanations and arguments given. The solicitor hired to help through this process was quite surprised and pleased by how thoroughly, and willingly, they accepted the explanations.

Also, the prayer that the caseworker would be sympathetic and understanding was granted by more than what was asked or imagined. The workers currently in the country are free to remain. And in the future, it may be easier to sponsor new missionaries.
