*L & B - became Christians in India, looked for a church found us, became part of the Bible study, and part of our community. Their baby was also baptized.

*A—an elderly lady, from a Sikh background was met last year when a member of LEAP week came to her door, she came to church and Bible study, was loved by the community, and was willing to have the idols taken from her home.

Their common theme was they felt welcome, accepted, found a home.

“Our experience, based on Scripture is that prolonged exposure to the gospel through preaching and teaching, in a community of love, welcome and embracing grace along with celebration in worship, is the key to reaching the broken, rebellious, and hopeless world.” (Bob Heppe)

Last week another challenge was before us with 21 Americans arriving for our London Evangelism and Prayer (LEAP) week. They have come to learn, to serve, to pray, and to witness to the community of Indians living in Southall and Harrow area.
