Food Cupboard Update- 9-4-18

The food cupboard was open for 4 weeks in August. Attendance averaged 57 households per week. The Monday night (New Life Family only) average was 7 households registering. The total weight of groceries distributed was 1516 lbs per week. This demand was met through purchases from Philabundance Food Bank, Glenside Post Office, North Wales Post Office, the Abington Police and Fire food drive, Fresh Market and Giant. The total weight of produce distributed was 389 lbs per week.

Donations of Crackers to the Perpetual Food Drive are always welcome. **We are also in need of plastic and paper bags.** Please drop off your donations at the pantry by the Weldon Room or in the baskets in the lobby off of the main parking lot.
